# **System Overview**

- System provides a comprehensive and consistent data reporting mechanism for facilities and entities to comply with the regulation
- · Includes emissions and non-emissions data
- Initial version set for public release January 2009

## **Report Information**

- Detailed emissions and fuel data
- Fuel consumption data at meter level
- Power transactions
- Internal/external reports
- Verification information

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# **Software Development**

- Software developed by Perrin Quarles Associates (PQA)
- Software code based on EATS/CRAVe (originally developed by PQA for USEPA)
- Other Programs which use EATS/CRAVe

TCR Voluntary GHG Emissions Inventory Reporting

- RGGI CO2 Allowance Tracking System

 NADATS NY Acid Deposition & Allowance Tracking System (SO2 & NOx trading program)

## **Database Hosting & Security**

- PQA will provide software application management services
- Web servers and database hosting through third party
- Security of reporter information
- Security of total system addressed in consideration of possible market system

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# **Testing and Feedback**

- Limited beta testing of system by industry representatives from sectors subject to the rule
- Reporters asked to comment on
  - System "bugs"
  - Critical functionality
  - Enhancements
- Anticipate on-going feedback from all reporters for future improvements
