11:15 a.m. **Hazardous Waste Compliance for Industry**, Jojo Comandante, *Supervising Hazardous Materials Specialist, Los Angeles County Fire Department / Health Hazardous Materials Division*

The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Subtitle C establishes a federal program to manage hazardous wastes for its entire existence to ensure that hazardous waste is handled in a manner that protects human health and the environment. The EPA has established regulations and procedures for the generation, transportation, storage and disposal of hazardous waste. The talk will give a brief overview of the hazardous waste regulations, and discuss those regulations that industries are most likely to receive a violation notice. These include not properly labelling and closing of hazardous waste containers, failures to minimize the release of hazardous waste, inadequate permits to transfer, store, and/or treat hazardous waste, having no proper contingency plan, and having inadequate training records.
